#### **Notes**

In the key configs screen, the icon with 12 little grey dots denotes a key command that was "Learned by Key Position"

In the key config screen, a command with a bullet symbol in front indicates that command is available via keystroke only (not in menus).

"Enter" and "Return" are not the same thing!
"Enter" = Fn+Return
